





G. I. Hereford was born George Isaac Huntinford in 1748, educated at Winchester College and at Oxford. Afterwards was Curate of Compton, south of Winchester before becoming Master of his old school and the became Warden Winchester College from 1780 until his death in 1832. He continued to live in the Wardens Lodgings until his death.





he did not expect to called on to pay until Lady Day.
